Beginning Monday, March 23, all campus buildings will require an All Card for swipe access. Housing & Meal Plan Credits



Students who lived in campus housing will receive a prorated credit based on the closure date of March 23, 2020. The credit reflects the unused portion of housing charges for the remainder of spring semester.

Students with a meal plan will receive a prorated credit of unused meals. The credits will vary by student, based upon each students' meal plan and unused meals. Unused dining dollar balances will be rolled forward to be used during the 2020-2021 academic year.

Room and board credits will appear on your monthly eBill, published on Wednesday, April 15th. Credits will first be applied towards existing balances. If your account has a credit, please read the detailed email sent in the Student Newsletter.

- Staff is working remotely, and buildings have been locked down. Swipe card access only

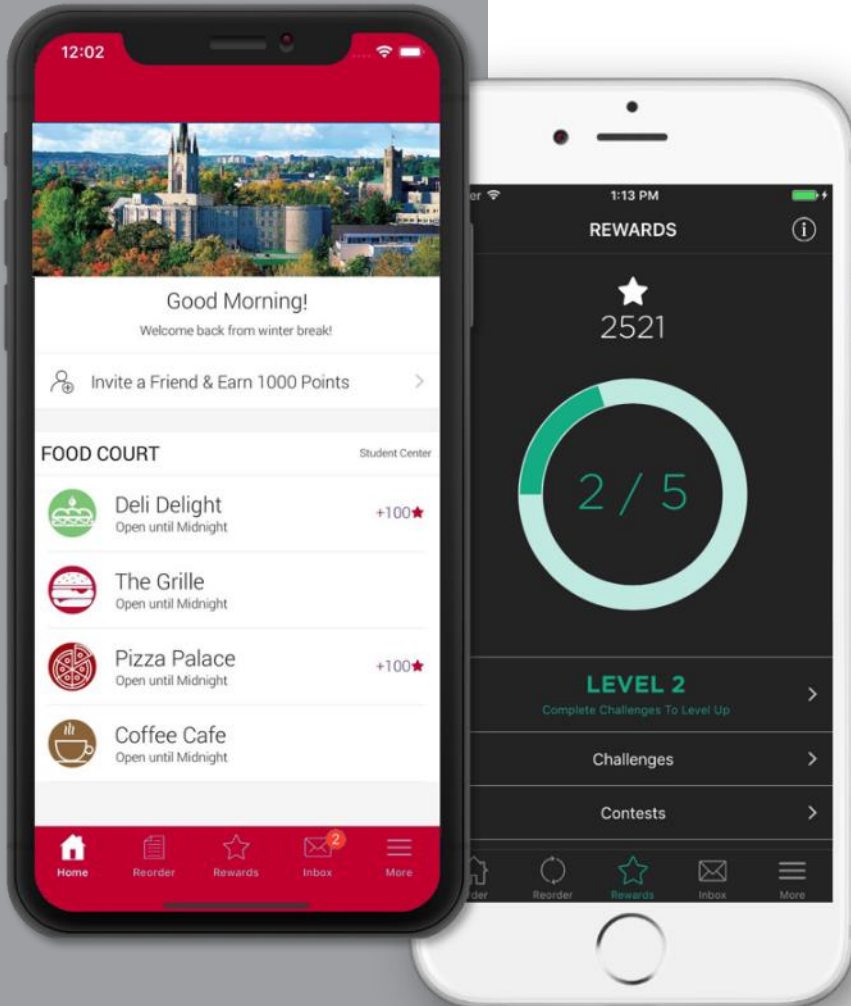
COVID-19 IMPACT

- All retail dining is closed. One dining hall is open with limited social distance seating and carry-out service for the remaining students.
- The Student Union CSTORE has been put on the mobile app with Essential items
- All students were required to vacate residence halls, this was not a move out, their belongings were left behind. Approximately 250-300 students that applied for an exception remain on campus
 - Students residing in 6 dorms have been requested to return to campus for belongings as those buildings are being converted into a hospital.

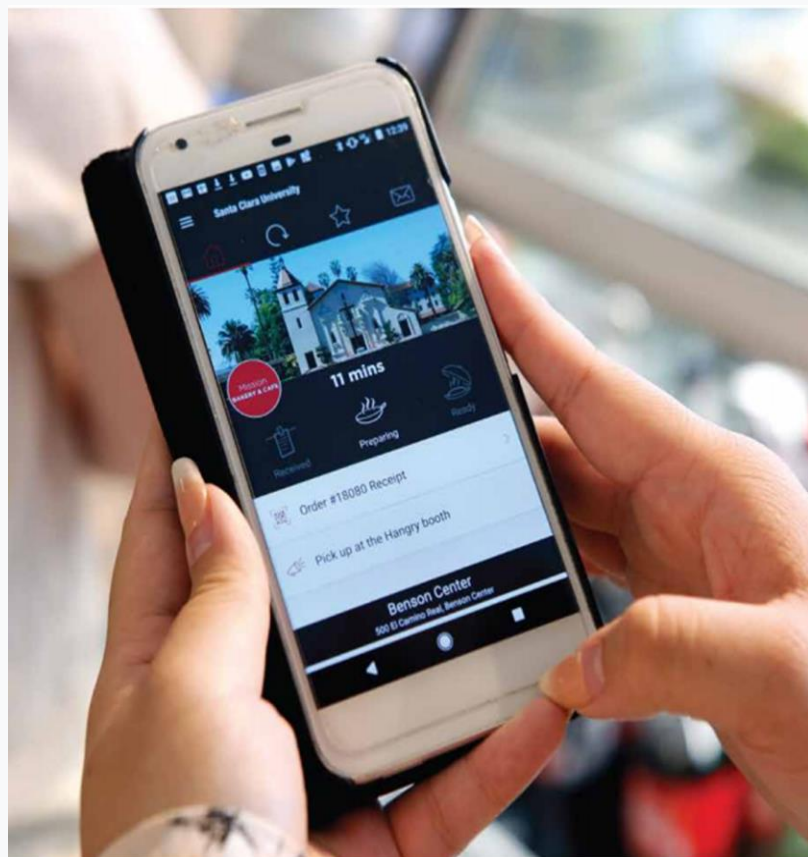

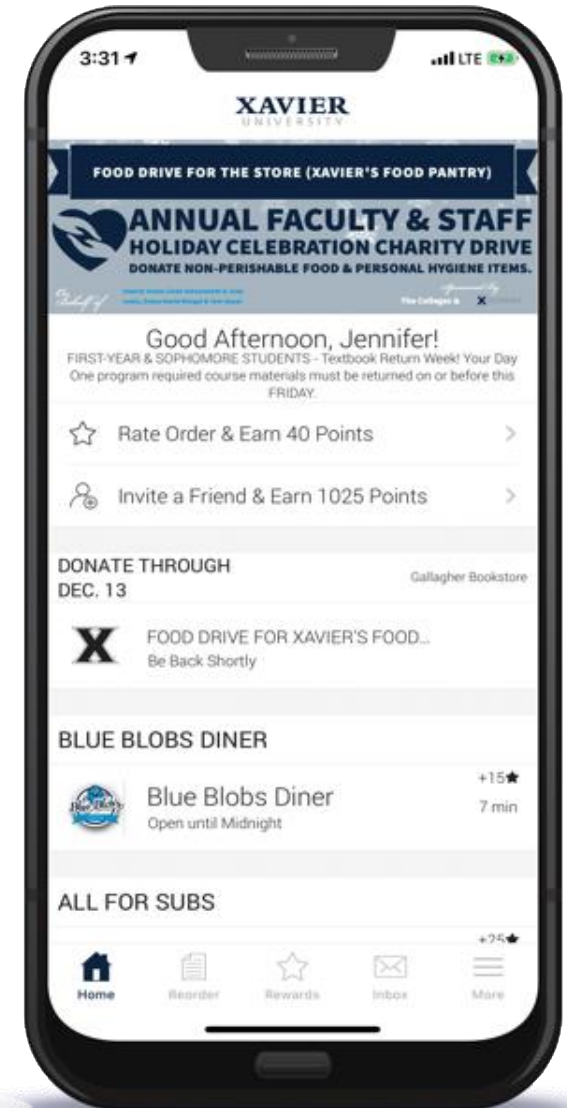

There are many things you may need right now. Here are some ways we thought we could help.

Market on Craver Essentials Program

The Market on Craver Essentials Program allows you to order food items and essentials through the NinerDiners Mobile App.

Download the Transact Mobile Ordering app ([iOS](#) or [Android](#)) and select UNC Charlotte, then tap Market on Craver Essentials. First, select the product category (listed across the top) you wish to order from, then tap "Customize" to select items to add to your cart.

You can pay with Declining Balance, Optional Dining Account funds, 49er Account funds or a credit card.

To pick up your order in store, simply show the cashier your receipt. *Don't forget to bring your 49er Card. Your card is required to access the Union building.*

For curbside pick up, drive to Student Union Lane and park near the NinerDiners curbside pick-up sign [near the Student Union loading dock turnaround](#). Call the number on the sign to let us know you have arrived.

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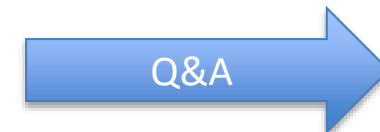


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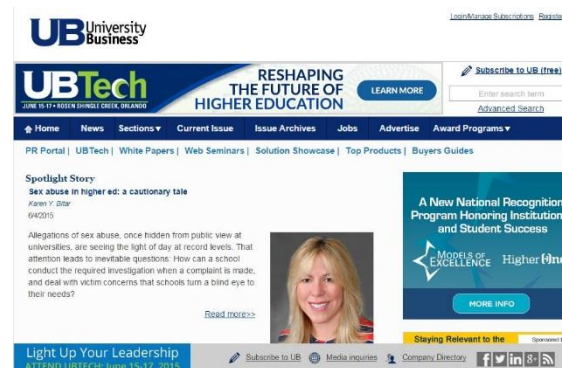


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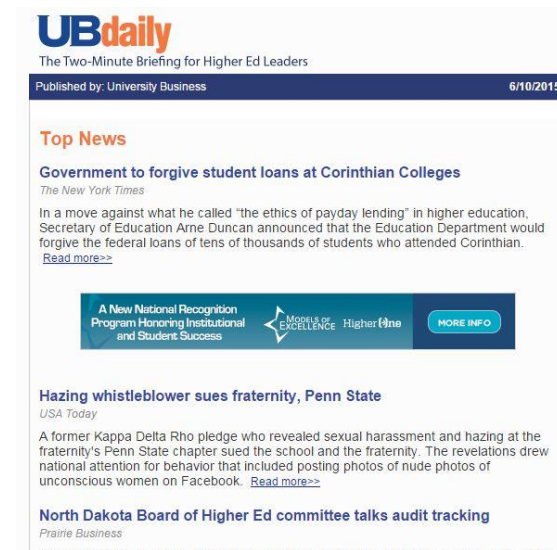
