Step 1: Authentic Assessment


How will you assess learning?

 - Align Assessments/Objectives



Course Map Sample


Tip: Chunking your content on each page increases readability and accessibility.



Step 3: Design Your Modules


Include:

- Engaging content
 - Images and videos
- Student Centered Activities
 - Interactive
 - Relevant
- Authentic Assessments
 - Student video projects
 - Integrated quizzes (video)
 - Peer video conversations




Instructor Created Video = Humanizing


